

SAFER AT HOME ORDER

Executive Order 20-91 April 3rd, 2020 - April 30th, 2020

- Requires Senior Citizens and individuals with underlying conditions to stay at home and limit the risk of exposure
- All individuals should limit their outings and interactions outside of their home to only those necessary to obtain, provide, or conduct essential activity
- 1 Encourages all individuals to work from home

- Businesses are encouraged to provide delivery, carry-out, or curbside services
- Essential activities include attending religious services, participating in recreational activities, caring for a loved one
- Essential activities do not include gathering for social activity and CDC guidelines should be maintained

✓ YOU CAN

- Go to the grocery store and pharmacy
- · Go to medical appointments
- Go to a restaurant for takeout
- Care for or support family members or friends
- Participate in recreational activities such as walking, hiking, jogging, fishing, and hunting
- Care for your pets

X YOU CANNOT

- Go to work unless you are providing essential services
- Visit friends or family unless they need assistance or it is an emergency
- Maintain less than 6 feet between yourself and others
- Visit individuals in the hospital, or other residential care facility
